

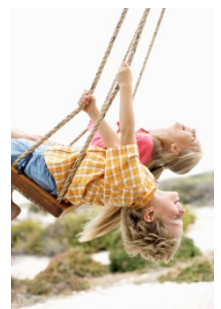


## **Friends of Poulders Play Area (FPPA) Newsletter**

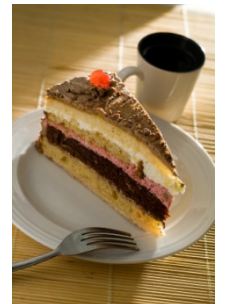


### **Committee Meeting, 2, The Ramparts, Knightrider Street, Friday 14 October, 8.00 pm**
